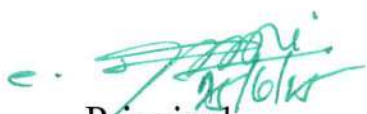

A Library Orientation Program was successfully conducted on **27th June 2025**, exclusively for the **first-year undergraduate students** of K.M.G. College of Arts and Science (Autonomous), Gudiyattam. The program aimed to introduce students to the academic and digital resources of the library and promote independent learning practices. The session was designed to be both informative and motivational, highlighting the importance of reading habits, digital tools like N-LIST and NDLI, and the role of the library in academic development.

Objectives of the Program:

- To orient first-year students to the structure and functioning of the central library.
- To explain the usage of **N-LIST**, **NDLI**, and other digital academic resources.
- To encourage responsible and regular library usage among students.
- To familiarize students with library rules, borrowing policies, and online access tools.
- To develop digital literacy and information-searching skills essential for academic success.
- To promote reading habits and awareness of open-access learning content.

Program Summary

1. Inaugural Session:

- The event commenced with the rendition of **Tamizhthai Vaazhthu**, setting a respectful and traditional tone for the programme.
- This was followed by a **Welcome Address** delivered by **Dr. K.S.Karuna**, Assistant Professor, PG & Research Department of Commerce, who extended warm greetings to the participants and dignitaries.

- Q&A session for student queries
- Use of real-time demonstration for login procedures

5. Student and Staff Involvement:

- Students from various departments were divided into 3 batches
- Technical support and coordination handled by **Mr. K. Monish Kumar**, Technical Assistant
- Faculty from different departments ensured active participation
- Library staff assisted in managing digital access and student movement
